Ed Sniffen is the Deputy Director of the Hawaii Department of Transportation's Highways Division, which is responsible for 2,500 lane miles of highway and 741 bridges across six Hawaiian Islands. Ed has oversight of over 1,000 employees in four district offices, six branches and four staff offices. His mission is the development and improvement of our highway transportation systems and people to facilitate sustainable safe and efficient travel and commerce statewide.

Among his key responsibilities as Deputy Director for Highways is delivering the Division's safety, preservation, and improvement initiatives efficiently based on data, available resources, and future need. Ed carries out these responsibilities through close collaboration with the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Highways Administration, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, the Hawaii State Legislature, County Administrations, and other transportation stakeholders.

Ed is driven to improve the Division's implementation of its key programs by modernizing its processes, partnerships and strategies to provide Hawaii's residents and visitors the quality of life and experiences they deserve with the resources at hand. Ed works to tie all levels of government, legislature, and our beloved communities together to achieve a common goal.

As the newly appointed Chair of the AASHTO Committee on Transportation System Security and Resilience, Ed is first trying to catch up with all the great work the committee and its former chairs have done, then work to improve how all states include resiliency in its daily operations.

Dr. Brennon Morioka is currently the Dean of the College of Engineering at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa. The College educates and prepares 1,500 students to face real world challenges in the areas of mechanical, electrical, civil, construction, computer, aerospace, and biomedical engineering. Students of the College have worked with approximately 60 faculty to do innovative research in all of these engineering fields.

Dr. Morioka is a licensed civil engineer in Hawai'i and California. He has served in multiple executive positions in Hawai'i. He was the General Manager for Electrification of Transportation at Hawaiian Electric Company (HECO), the Deputy Executive Director for the Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART), and the former Director for the State of Hawai'i Department of Transportation (HDOT). He has served as Vice President and Area Manager for CH2M HILL in the Honolulu Office, and as the Executive Vice President of Shioi Construction. All of these positions have provided him with extensive experiences in both the public and private sectors in the engineering and business world.

Dr. Morioka received his Bachelor's and Master's of Science degrees in Civil Engineering from the University of California at Berkeley, and completed his doctoral studies here at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa.

He serves on the numerous boards of community service and non-profit organizations, including the Aloha Stadium Authority, the US Japan Council, Ahahui Koa Anuenue, Friends of 'Iolani Palace, Mothers Against Drunk Driving, as well as, serves as the

Chairman for PICHTR, the Pacific International Center for High Technology Research.

Brennon is a graduate of Iolani School. He is married to his wife, Jeanine, of 20 years with three keiki, Taysia and identical twins, Brayden and Bronson.





Hollmann recorded at 2019 AACE International Annual Meeting. Mr. Hollmann presented a method called ratio-to-driver for cost estimate validation which it should start with establishing an explicit cost strategy (planning for bias) in the basis of estimate and estimating requirements documents and the validation's purpose is to assure this strategy was achieved.
