ENGINEERS WEEK IN HAWAII GOES VIRTUAL DUE TO COVID-19

The pandemic created by COVID-19 is causing changes to how engineers in Hawaii observe Engineers Week 2021. The traditional luncheon and banquet will be replaced by virtual events. The STEM-based event involving school students at an Oahu shopping center has been cancelled. Here is the schedule for Engineers Week 2021 to date.

Engineers Week in Hawaii traditionally began with the Kickoff luncheon at the Hale Koa hotel sponsored by the Society of American Military Engineers. This year's virtual event will be held on Tuesday, February 23 from 12 noon to 1:00 PM on ZOOM. Following the speaker the outgoing HCES chair will recognize the incoming chair. Details on the speaker and how to register will be forthcoming in the February Wiliki.

A virtual Engineers Week Event will substitute for the banquet on Friday, February 26, from 12 noon to 1:00 PM on ZOOM. The four 2021 Engineers Week awardees: Engineer of the Year, Young Engineer of the Year, Student Engineer of the Year, and HCES Lifetime

Achievement awardee; will be recognized. Information on how to register for the event will be published in the February Wiliki.

The speaker is William (Bill) Chapman, the Dean of the School of Architecture at UHM. Educated at Columbia (M.S. in Historic Preservation) and at Oxford University (D.Phil. in Anthropology), Chapman has worked extensively throughout the Pacific and Asia and has served as a visiting lecturer at numerous universities in Southeast Asia. He has written on subjects ranging from the historic Volcano House Hotel in Hawaii to the Wright Brothers National Memorial at Kitty Hawk, North Carolina. His latest publication is Ancient Sites of Southeast Asia: A Traveler's Guide through History, Ruins, and Landscapes (Bangkok and Honolulu: River Books and University of Hawaii Press, 2018). A four-time Fulbright scholar (Italy, Cambodia, and twice in Thailand), he received the Frank Haines Award for Lifetime Contributions to Historic Preservation from the Historic Hawai'i Foundation in 2011. Since 2016, he has been a Fellow of the Explorers Club of New York. Chapman previously served as the Chair of the Department of American Studies and as the Director of the Graduate Certificate Program in Historic Preservation at UHM.





ASCE mourns the loss of Horst Brandes, Ph.D., P.E., F. ASCE

It is with a saddened and heavy heart that we announce the passing of one of our past presidents of the Hawaii Section, Dr. Horst Brandes, who passed shortly before Thanksgiving. Many of us knew Horst through his active involvement with ASCE; he was the 2003 ASCE Hawaii Section President, a Region 8 Governor from 2011 to 2014, and was active on many Society committees including Raise the Bar and Civil Engineering Technologist. Horst was also a beloved professor with the University of Hawaii's College of Engineering over the last 23 years and many of us are his former students.

Current ASCE Hawaii Section President, Dayna Nemoto-Shima, remembers Dr. Brandes from her time at UH, "Going into geotechnical engineering, I think I took all of the courses Dr. Brandes taught. I remember he took us on a field trip to see a landslide that took place in a residential area. It was so impactful to see the damage and then hear him talk about his work with the homeowners. I think that was when I realized that the field I was going into really has an impact on people's lives. I owe a lot to Dr. Brandes for where I am today."

We ask that you keep his family, including his wife Patricia (Tricia) and their two daughters, Anna and Isabella, in your thoughts. We also encourage you to express your condolences to the family and share with them any fond memories of Horst. 
